

## General Poster Information

The poster sessions will take place **May 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>** at the TELUS Convention Centre on the exhibit floor.

### Hanging

**The posters will hang for the entire conference and must be posted the Sunday preceding the conference or Monday before 9am.** Check in at the desk located just inside the gray exhibit entry door on the west side of the exhibit floor (sign for exhibitors only). Provide your name to the people working the desk and they will check you off the list and confirm your board number. The ideal time to hang your poster is Sunday afternoon between 3 and 7pm, our poster chair will be available during this time to assist.

### Presentations

The presentation times are scheduled from **10:00am - 10:30am and 2:45pm - 3:15pm**, but you are requested to be at your poster for the entire morning/afternoon of your presentation to answer questions. ### Poster Presentation Format

Presenters are to prepare a 10 minute Mini-Oral presentation to be delivered at the scheduled time for the judges. Poster presenters are also encouraged to present less formal presentations throughout the duration of the day to other interested delegates.

### Poster Layout

Poster display panel dimensions are 4 ft. (vertical) by 8 ft. (horizontal). **If you need two panels, please advise Breanne at the email address below.**

Your poster should include both the title and authors of your presentation. Make the poster easy to follow in case it is viewed when you are not present. The poster should have a clear starting and ending point. Arrows or numbers should be used to define poster progression and generally should follow left to right, top to bottom rules.

### Poster and Oral Presentation Selection

If you select to present an oral and poster presentation, the organizing committee will work with the schedule to ensure your presentation times do not overlap. **If you sign up to present both, please note, you are agreeing to present both the oral (slides) presentation and the poster presentation.**
